Denver Jewish Day School - Upper Division Principal - Job Description

The Upper Division Principal is in charge of the day-to-day operations of the Upper Division (UD). The Upper Division Principal reports directly to the Head of School/CEO.

Duties include:

- Design, evaluate and update the UD curriculum in conjunction with the faculty.
- Monitor the implementation and execution of the UD curriculum.
- Select textbooks and provide for educational resources and materials in cooperation with the faculty.
- Ensure the implementation and/or expansion of curricular, and extracurricular activities in the UD.
- Develop and oversee programs of educational, artistic, athletic, and social nature for students and, as appropriate, parents.
- Work in conjunction with the Lower Division Principal and administrative team to ensure continuity of the overall K-12 curriculum.
- Assign, supervise, mentor, evaluate, and recruit (as needed) faculty and staff for UD.
- Plan and conduct faculty meetings and coordinate and supervise faculty committees as appropriate.
- Provide opportunities for continued professional development of faculty.
- Ensure a sense of accountability in areas of instruction and student achievement.
- Promote a positive sense of camaraderie, professionalism, and trust in the workplace.
- Monitor the progress of students.
- Monitor, evaluate, counsel, and recommend where appropriate, a proper course of action educationally for students and their families.
- Assist in matters of retention and recruitment.
- Promote and represent the school positively in the community.
- Supervise the UD budget.
- Ensure that the UD is in compliance with ACIS standards.
- Provide an open door policy to parents and staff for concerns, ideas, etc.
- Actively participate in school leadership teams, committees and their initiatives.
- Assist in recruitment and provide assistance in the hiring process for extra-divisional DJDS employees at the request of the Head of School/CEO.
